Ruby began the meeting with a prayer and devotions.

Council approved the minutes for the March council meeting.

**PASTOR BOB ABRAMS** from the Synod visited to help guide council on the steps that need to be taken to call a new pastor since Pastor Wolf will be leaving at the end of July. Expect this to be a long process. It will not take place quickly.

He suggested we adapt to our new situation rather than"react."

He also added, in case we are wondering, that the word "Synod" means "Walking together along the way."

He informed us that we have fellowship with many church denominations and named a few we can consider during the call process. Among them are the Episcopal Church, United Methodist, Presbyterian – USA, Reformed Church of Christ and Moravian.

He also told us there is an organization in Lancaster called Lancaster Lutherans Together if we care to talk with them. This would widen our contacts for advice or suggestions.

FINANCE – Alan Fisher, President, went over the latest financial figures. We are getting good returns on investment. Alan stated that for the first time, there was not quite enough to make a full payment on our ceiling loan.
