

Passed away on January 24, 2024 and bequeathed St John's church \$20,000. At the May council meeting it was voted to put \$10,000 of that money toward the payoff of the church ceiling. With a unanimous decision council decided to move the money to place on the principle of the loan. This donation will definitely help in the paying off of the loan.

Following is a write up as told to me for a Spotlight in our Spirit.



LEOLA CREIGLOW

Leola has lived her entire life in and around this area. Her early years were in Jefferson and then her family moved to the Gender Road area and currently lives in Canal Winchester. She walked her entire first year of school across a long covered bridge, which has been replaced with a more "modern" bridge. Leola was one of five children. She had two brothers and three sisters. Virginia Behrens another member of St John's was Leola's sister.

Leola's church experience began at Salem Church which she walked to each Sunday. She became a member of St John's in 1940.

Leola and her husband, Homer, who has passed away, have three sons and one daughter. Her daughter is the only child that lives in the area. Her sons live in Kentucky, New Mexico and San Diego. On one of Leola's trips to San Diego, she drove home by herself in three days!

Leola has many talents. She has beautifully etched mirrors and glass which she has done. She does woodworking, sewing, quilt making among other crafty projects. Her husband whittled and she has some beautiful pieces which he did. All of these items are displayed in Leola's home. They are truly works of art. I really don't think there is anything Leola could not do if she puts her mind to it!!!

For 10 years Leola taught 4H in the summers with loaned sewing machines from Singer. She began with just 2 girls and when she retired she had 22 girls in her class. The girls would enter their sewing projects in the Lancaster Fair where several of them won.

Leola is such a caring person. She has cared and assisted a number of people in the community and also cared for her Mother and helped with her sister before her sister entered Winchester Trail Inn in Canal Winchester.

She is definitely a beautiful women, inside and out with a strong faith.

At the time of Leola's death she was 103 years old.
